Sickness Policy

In the event of your child being ill, the Nursery Manager/Out of School Co-ordinator should be informed of their absence, this can be done by contacting the administration team. If your child is unwell during their time at Nursery/Out of School Club you will be contacted. It is therefore essential the administration system has at least two numbers on which yourself or your representative can be contacted. These should be kept up to date.

Under no circumstances can a child be admitted to Nursery/Out of School Club with a high temperature, sickness and/or diarrhoea or any other communicable disease (a list of which is available at the Nursery/Out of School Club).

Staff are unable to give consent for any medical treatment – please see your contract – therefore, a consent form must be signed. These are held in your child's room.

Children cannot be admitted back into Nursery/ Out of School Club until 48hours after starting a course of anti-biotics.

The setting has a responsibility to inform Local Authority Proper Officers under the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) Regulations 1988 and OfSTED in the event of a notifiable disease being contracted, for example, food poisoning. Please see www.hpa.org.uk.
